


VIRTUAL PRODUCTION Virtual Production is the use of real-time technology throughout production.


IN-CAMERA VFX (ICVFX)

The ability to mix live action footage and computer graphics together to create shots in real-time, using an LED wall to composite shots in-camera.





The LED wall creates an immersive surrounding experience around the real scene and actors, we refer to it as an LED volume stage.



The Volume




LED Wall with GS




Brain Bar - This is the central nervous center of a virtual production, where real-time hardware and software are controlled.



Camera Frustum and Outer Frustum





Frustum - The regions of a virtual world that appears as a viewport to the camera.
